Angie Cauthorn: Angie Cauthorn, stroke survivor, aphasia advocate, Eagles fan, and cat mom, is a champion for stroke and aphasia patients. She founded the ROSA (Resource Orientation for Stroke & Aphasia) conference, co-founded ARCH (Aphasia Resource Collaboration Hub), and co-hosts the international fan-favorite podcast called Brain Friends. She is also a member of aphasia organizations that support those affected by these conditions, including serving on the Board of Directors for the National Aphasia Association. Maura Silverman: Maura is the Executive Director of the National Aphasia Association. Prior to this dream job, Maura founded the Triangle Aphasia Project Unlimited in NC. Her career as a Speech Language Pathologist allowed her the opportunity to serve persons with aphasia and their families across the continuum of care. Despite the incredible opportunities that have been allotted to Maura throughout her career, she credits her lived experience as a carepartner for her mom as the source of her greatest lessons.
